

RESOLUTION #202 - 2016

Requesting Approval of Items of Revenue and Appropriation NJS 40A:4-87 2017 Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Grant

WHEREAS, NJS 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the Director may also approve the insertion of an appropriation for the equal amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate, in the county of Atlantic, New Jersey, hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2016 in the sum of \$137,500.00, which is now available as a revenue from the South Jersey Transportation Planning Organization's FY 2017 Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Grant.

Pursuant to the provision of the statute, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the like sum of \$137,500.00 is hereby appropriated under the caption Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of NJS 40A:4-85, the City of Margate hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to make the following correction in the 2016 budget:
