### **Public Comment:**

John Sewell- 22 West Drive- Speaks on taxpayer money with regards to Shared Services and School Board.

Art Cautilli- 114 N. Lancaster Ave. Speaks on School Systems class sizes.

John Gottlieb -109 S. Quincy Ave. Speaks on Beach Replenishment Project and the inability to use Quincy Ave. beach for a very long time. He inquires as to the completion date. Mr.

Blumberg informs Mr. Gottlieb that right now Quincy Avenue is the staging area.

Larry Campbell- Balsley Losco- Speaks on Rental and Sales impact since "Beach Replenishment Project" started. He request a completion date be set for May 2018.

Lynn Gottlieb- 109 S. Quincy Avenue. Speaks on the effect to the rental business for this community and the need for the dunes to be astatically pleasing.

Elaine Charny - 14 S. Brunswick- Speaks on beach condition due to the fall out pipes. She inquires as to the location of the handicap access locations.

Mel Taylor- 4800 Boardwalk, Ventnor, NJ- Presents a digital on Petition against "Beach Replenish Project".
