WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonably accurate estimates in advance; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S. 40A: 10-1 et seq. provides for receipt of budgeted funds by the municipality to provide for the operating costs to administer this act; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides the dedicated revenues anticipated from the Self-Insurance Program Trust are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirement:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The Governing Body does hereby request permission of the Director of Local Government Services to pay expenditures of the Self-Insurance Program created in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S. 40A:10-1 et seq.

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR THE DEDICATION BY RIDER FOR STORM RECOVERY TRUST FUND PURSUANT TO P.L. 2013, c.271 and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-62.1

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonably accurate estimates in advance; and

WHEREAS, P.L.2013, c.271 and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-62.1 provides for receipt of Storm Recovery Trust Funds by the municipality to provide for the operating costs to administer this act; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013, c.271 permits municipalities to lapse unexpended balances budgeted annually for snow removal and other storm recovery costs; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides the Director of Local Government Services may approve expenditures of monies by dedication by rider.

WHEREAS, Roger McLarnon, Qualified Purchasing Agent, submitted a letter of recommendation that the contract be awarded to Edmunds GovTech, 301 Tilton Road, Northfield, NJ 08225 for Software Support and Software Managed Services for Margate City Municipal Clerk's Office in the amount of \$12,220.00; and

RESOLUTION #213-2023

AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY'S QUALIFIED PURCHASING AGENT (QPA) TO AWARD CONTRACTS BELOW THE BIDDING THRESHOLD AS ESTABLISHED BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2023 the governor signed P.L. 2023, c. 30 titled Election Transparency Act into law; and

WHERAS, on August 8, 2023 the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services issued Local Finance Notice (LFN 2023-14) which prescribed that the governing body may delegate the authority to award a contract having anticipated value in excess of \$17,500.00 but below the increased bid threshold of a Local Public Contracts Law contracting unit with a Qualified Purchasing Agent (i.e. a "window contract" to the QPA); and
