#### **ORDINANCE #10-2020**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 75-2 FEES AND CHARGES

**Be It Ordained** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey the Chapter 75 of the Code of the City of Margate shall be amended and supplemented as follows (not less than two-thirds of the full membership thereof affirmatively concurring):

# SECTION 1: § 75-2 Fees and charges. Shall be changed to read as follows:

In order to provide the necessary funds to improve, maintain and police the beaches, the following fees shall be charged for such facilities:

- A. No fees shall be charged to or collected from any person under the age of 12 years.
- B. Ten dollars per person per season, provided that application is made to the proper authorities on or before May 31 of the bathing season.
- C. Twenty dollars per person per season in the event that application is made to the proper authorities subsequent to the 31st day of May of the bathing season.

- D. Three dollars and fifty cents for senior citizens 65 years and older per season, provided that application is made to the proper authorities on or before May 31 of the bathing season.
- E. Ten dollars per person per week for any week or fractional part thereof of the bathing season. Weekly badges will be valid from 12:00 noon Friday until 12:00 noon of the following Friday.
- F. Twelve dollars for the purchase of each holiday beach badge. These badges will be valid for the following summer season only.
- G. No privilege, right, badge or other evidence to use the beaches of the City of Margate City issued to or to be issued upon the payment of any fees provided shall be sold or leased to any person or entity by anyone other than the City of Margate City or its duly authorized representative,. Specifically, The City of Margate City or its duly authorized representative shall be the sole and exclusive vendor and/or purchase or lease said badges from anyone other than the City of Margate City or its duly authorized representative.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect upon	final adoption and publication in
the manner provided by law.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Atlantic County Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency Management for the Atlantic County Radio Network.

## RESOLUTION #190-2020 KNOCK OUT OPIOID ABUSE DAY OCTOBER 6, 2020

WHEREAS, New Jersey is in the midst of a life-threatening opioid abuse epidemic; and WHEREAS, the Partnership for a Drug-Free New Jersey has designated October 6, 2020, as Knock Out Opioid Abuse Day – an initiative with a dual purpose: to raise awareness of the potential for dependency on prescribed pain medicine and its link to heroin use rates in our state, reduce stigma of addiction and shine a light on the need for recovery support, and communicate to physicians information on safer prescribing messages found in the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention guidelines for prescribing opioids, which include considering other therapies, setting realistic treatment goals with patients and discussing with patients the positives and negatives of opioids; and

# Amendment to Contract Between FMBA Local 41 and City of Margate October 1, 2020

The City of Margate and FMBA Local 41 hereby agree to implement changes to the Terms and Conditions of Employment in the current collective bargaining agreement as follows:

- D. TERMINAL LEAVE: Effective October 1, 2020 through May 1, 2021, a terminal leave agreement between Margate City and FMBA Local 41 will be in effect. The terms of this agreement are as follows:
  - 1. Any Firefighter with twenty-five (25) years or more of service no later than May 1, 2021 is eligible to elect this benefit provision.
  - 2. Any Firefighter who has 25 Years of Service prior to December 31, 2020, must retire by January 1, 2021 to be eligible.
  - 3. Firefighters not eligible to retire by January 1, 2021 but eligible no later than May 1, 2021 must retire at the first date of eligibility.
  - 4. Notification of intent to retire shall be made to the Fire Chief no later than sixty (60) days prior to retirement.
  - 5. The Firefighter shall be compensated for his/her accumulated sick leave using the formula in the existing contract: Article XVI Retirement and Terminal Leave Section A.
  - 6. Each Eligible Firefighter electing this provision shall receive an additional \$27,500.
  - 7. At the discretion of the employer, eligible Firefighters may receive the additional \$27,500 in one lump sum payment or in yearly installments within a three year period.
  - 8. All of a participating Firefighter's accumulated 2020 or 2021 sick days will be pro-rated as of the retirement date.
  - 9. Any Firefighter eligible to retire under the terms of this provision electing not to exercise his option to retire shall not thereafter be eligible for any subsequent retirement incentive option during his tenure as a Margate Firefighter.
  - 10. This contract amendment shall be applicable only for the period October 1, 2020 through May 1, 2021.
