The Margate City Board of Commissioners held a work meeting on the above date at 4:00 p.m. The meeting began with a flag salute & roll call: Mr. Becker, Mr. Amodeo and Mr. Blumberg were present. **Items for Discussion:**

**Department Reports:**

Mr. Ricciotti: Monitoring storm in the Atlantic. Beaches are in great shape. Very busy doing utility work.

Chief Wolfson: Keeping an eye on the storm.

Mr. Deane: Informs the Public about the RFP submitted for Phase II Post Sandy Grant. Master Plan will be included in the Grant. Four employee labor contracts end December 31<sup>st</sup>. Negotiations will begin September 1<sup>st</sup>. Phase I of the Gas Company instillation is completed and there will be repaving of 90% of those roads. Phase II will begin in the fall.

Mr. Abbott: Dredging project is moving forward slowly. There will be a meeting on August 28<sup>th</sup>.

Ms. Casey: Nothing to report.

Mr. Blumberg: Nothing to report.

Mr. Galantino: Nothing to report.

Mr. Amodeo: Compliments to Chief Tabasso and the MCBP for their second place finish at the South Jersey Championship.

Mr. Becker: Public works will resume picking up properly disposed of carpeting and it can also be dropped off at the city yard.

Mr. Verna: Everything is going well.
