**Approval the Submittal of a Grant Application and Execute a Grant Agreement with the
New Jersey Department of Transportation for the Bikeway Grant Program
Bike-2014-Margate City -00061**

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation is accepting applications for the Bikeway Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, a primary objective of the NJDOT Bikeway Grant Program is to create 1,000 miles of dedicated bike paths; and

WHEREAS, this program is available to all counties and municipalities in the State of New Jersey and the grant program does not require a local match; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate carefully considers grant programs that assist the City in achieving projects and programs that are priorities for the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate proposed new bike lanes on Atlantic Avenue from Coolidge to Fredericksburg Avenues;

WHEREAS, this proposed project meets many of the criteria of the NJDOT since it creates enhanced bikeway mileage, and continue the three lane configuration of Atlantic Avenue from the Longport border to the Ventnor border, and is a construction ready project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City Commission of the City of Margate formally approves a NJDOT grant application for the above stated project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application identified as Bike-2014-Margate-00007 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the City of Margate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the City of Margate and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
