**Approval to Submit a Grant Application and Execute a Grant Agreement with the
New Jersey Department of Transportation for the Safe Streets to Transit Program
SST-2014-Margate City-00078**

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation is accepting applications for the Municipal Aid Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, this program is available to all municipalities in the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, this grant program does not require a local match; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate carefully considers grant programs that assist the City in achieving projects and programs that are priorities for the community; and

WHEREAS, the Safe Streets to Transit Program may fund intersection improvements, new sidewalks, safety enhancements, pedestrian signals, traffic calming measures and ornamental lighting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Governing Body of the City of Margate formally approves that grant application for the above stated project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an electronic grant application identified as SST-2014-Margate City-00078 to the New Jersey Department of Transportation on behalf of the City of Margate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the City of Margate and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
