

**RESOLUTION #42 OF 2013 AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A
CONTRACT FOR MUNICIPAL ENGINEER**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate has determined it has a need to acquire Municipal Engineering Services as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of *N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5* and Margate City Ordinance 36 of 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent has determined and certified in writing that the value of the acquisition will exceed \$17,500; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated term of the contract is three years and may be extended one time as approved by the Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, Remington, Vernick & Walberg Engineers has submitted a proposal dated February 2013 indicating they will provide Municipal Engineering services for a fee not to exceed \$22,000; and

WHEREAS, Remington, Vernick & Walberg Engineers has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Remington, Vernick & Walberg Engineers has not made any contributions to a political or candidate committee in the City of Margate in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit Remington, Vernick & Walberg Engineers from making any contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds for the within Contract.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute and the City Clerk to attest to a contract between the City of Margate and Remington, Vernick & Walberg Engineers for municipal engineering services in an amount not to exceed \$22,000.
- 2.** The Business Disclosure Entity Certification and the Determination of Value shall be placed on file with this resolution
- 3.** A notice of this action shall be printed once in the Press of Atlantic City.
