

Resolution #41 of 2014
Establishing a Green Team Advisory Committee

WHEREAS, Margate works toward balancing its economic, social and environmental goals to assure community sustainability, and

WHEREAS, On June 20, 2013 the City Commission adopted Resolution #134-2013 “Supporting Participation in the Sustainable Jersey Municipal Certification Program” and authorizing the Public Works Commissioner “to serve as Margate City’s agent for the Sustainable Jersey Municipal Certification Process”, and

WHEREAS, In order to aid in achieving State Certification, the temporary Green Team needs to be officially recognized and authorized to advise the City on ways to improve municipal operations with “Green” initiatives, which are economically and environmentally sound through research and evaluation,
