AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH COMMERCIAL UTILITY CONSULTANTS, INC. ("CUC") FOR THE SUPPLY OF ELECTRICITY TO RESIDENTIAL PARTICIPANTS OF THE CITY OF MARGATE AGGREGATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, by Ordinance #16 of 2013, the City of Margate City established the City of Margate Aggregation Program (the "Aggregation Program"), the purpose of which is to provide a savings to Margate City residents customers on their electrical bills; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 197 of 2013, the City of Margate entered into a Governmental Energy Aggregation Program and appointed Commercial Utility Consultants, Inc. ("CUC") of West Chester, PA to serve as the City's municipal energy aggregation consultant; and

WHEREAS, the City has decided that it is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Margate to terminate their participation in the Energy and Natural Gas Aggregation Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Margate County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that the City of Margate hereby elects to terminate its' participation in the Governmental Energy Aggregation Program and hereby releases CUC as consultant for the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Solicitor is to provide notice and implement such other measures as to terminate the engagement with Commercial Utility Consultants, Inc. ("CUC") of West Chester PA.
