WHEREAS, the error was not caused by the taxpayer;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the governing body of the Taxing District of Margate City that the Assessor is hereby authorized to act as the agent for the Taxing District and file a Petition of Appeal or Appeals for the tax year 2017 with the Atlantic County Board of Taxation to correct such errors and assessments to the correct value; and

**THAT** a copy of any Petition of Appeal filed with the Atlantic County Board of Taxation under this Resolution be filed with the Municipal Clerk; and

**THAT** a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Atlantic County Board of Taxation with any such Petition of Appeal.
