

R E S O L U T I O N #228-2016
AUTHORIZING ASSESSOR TO FILE PETITIONS

WHEREAS, from time to time the Assessor discovers an error in calculation, transposing, measurement, or typographical errors, in the tax assessments on the tax list after the time the County Board of Taxation has certified the tax lists for the tax year; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the Taxing District of Margate City is desirous that every taxpayer pays his fair share of taxes; and

WHEREAS, if the above discovered errors are not correct, the taxpayers affected would not be paying their fair share of taxes; and

WHEREAS, the method for correcting such errors is to file a Petition of Appeal for the current tax year with the Atlantic County Board of Taxation; and

WHEREAS, the error was not caused by the taxpayer;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Taxing District of Margate City that the Assessor is hereby authorized to act as the agent for the Taxing District and file a Petition of Appeal or Appeals for the tax year 2017 with the Atlantic County Board of Taxation to correct such errors and assessments to the correct value; and

THAT a copy of any Petition of Appeal filed with the Atlantic County Board of Taxation under this Resolution be filed with the Municipal Clerk; and

THAT a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Atlantic County Board of Taxation with any such Petition of Appeal.
