**ORDINANCE #04-2016**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 269, WATER OF THE CODE OF  
THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC AND STATE OF  
NEW JERSEY**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Commissioners of the City of Margate, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Margate City Code Chapter 269, Water, shall be amended as follows:

§269-22 Bills and billing, C. shall be amended to read:

If a bill remains unpaid after nine (9) calendar days following the due date, notice will be served on the customer stating that the amount due us subject to interest at the rate of 8% per annum on the first \$1,500.00 and 18% per annum for any amount over \$1,500.00 retroactive to the first of the month. If said amount is paid not paid within 48 hours from the date of such notice, water supply will be discontinued. When the water is turned off under such conditions it will remain off until the amount owing is paid in full, together with the interest charges or until arrangements for payment in full, together with the interest charge, have been made to the satisfaction of the City, and a meter reconnection fee of \$20.00 has been paid. If the meter reconnect is requested at a time other than regular working hours of the department, the fee will be \$50.00. If the charges plus interest are not paid by the end of the fiscal year, unless other arrangements have been made, the property will be advertised for tax sale.

**SECTION 2:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

**SECTION 3:** This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
