RESOLUTION # 100 of 2013

AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, SOLICITOR AND
ENGINEER TO INVESTIGATE AND DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF
A SHORE FRONT PROTECTION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to have an investigation and feasibility study with regard to the implementation of a Shore Front Protection Project in conjunction with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and the United States Army Corps of Engineers; and

WHEREAS, said investigation shall include costs, funding, procurement of easements or resolution of title issues, drainage, access and all other reasonably related factors pertaining to the possible implementation by the City of Margate City of a Shore Protection Project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the City of Margate City, does hereby direct the City Administrator, Solicitor, Engineer and other related City officials, (hereinafter "Officials") to investigate and determine the feasibility of implementing a Shore Front Protection Project as specified herein and that said Officials advise the Governing Body of its findings and recommendations; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Officials are hereby authorized to perform any surveys, title searches, contact property owners and prepare any necessary deeds or easement agreements for those areas for said Shore Front Protection Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Officials are hereby authorized to pursue the availability of any funding at both the State and Federal levels for Shore Front Protection Projects that would be beneficial to the protection of the City of Margate City.
