

ORDINANCE NO. 12 of 2014

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING RENEWED CONSENT AND
PERMISSION TO SOUTH JERSEY GAS COMPANY TO USE THE
PUBLIC STREETS TO FURNISH GAS FOR LIGHT, HEAT AND
POWER IN THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY, ATLANTIC COUNTY

WHEREAS, South Jersey Gas Company, a corporation of the State of New Jersey, provides natural gas service to Margate City pursuant to the municipal consent first granted to South Jersey Gas Company in that certain Ordinance 707 passed on 7/31/1947 and

WHEREAS, South Jersey Gas Company now seeks, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 48:3-15, the consent of Margate City to renew Section [Number] of Ordinance 707 applicable to the use of the streets in Margate City by adopting the following Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by [MAYOR AND COUNCIL or TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE] of [MUNICIPALITY], County of [____] and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. That exclusive consent and permission is hereby renewed and granted to South Jersey Gas Company to lay and construct its pipes and mains and related appurtenances and facilities within the streets, alleys, squares and public places within [MUNICIPALITY] in the manner prescribed by N.J.S.A. 48:9-21, and subject to reasonable regulations imposed by ordinance or resolution with respect to the opening of streets and public places, subject to approval of such consent and permission by the Board of Public Utilities.

Section 2. This consent is granted for the entire geographical area of [MUNICIPALITY] and extend to the boundaries of [MUNICIPALITY] and shall remain in effect for a period of fifty (50) years from the date of final adoption of this Ordinance.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon posting, publication, final passage in the manner prescribed by law, and acceptance by South Jersey Gas Company.
