

ORDINANCE NO. 20 – 2014

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 75, BEACHES, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of Margate, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Margate City Code Chapter 75-3. Beach Badge Required shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

SECTION 2. Margate City Code Chapter 75-4. Bathing sessions; hours shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

SECTION 3. Margate City Code Chapter 75-6. Rules and regulations shall be amended as follows:

(1) §75.6(A) Swim/bathe designated areas, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(2) §75.6(B) Designated area for surfboat, boat, sailboat or raft, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(3) §75.6(C) No surf fishing during bathing hours, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(4) §75.6(D) Orders, directions, whistles any signals used by lifeguards/police, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(5) §75.6(E) No picnicking on beach, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(6) §75.6(F) No consumption of alcoholic beverages, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(7) §75.6(G) Dress, undress or otherwise disrobe, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(8) §75.6(H) No sleeping between sunset and sunrise, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(9) §75.6(I) No loud, indecent, obscene or offensive manner, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(10) §75.6(J) Disrupt and disturb public peace and dignity within beach area, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(11) §75.6(K) No tampering with or handling lifeguard boats or equipment, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(12) §75.6(L) No throwing, catching or batting baseball, football, basketball, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(13) §75.6(M) No refuse, debris, bottles, glass or paper, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(14) §75.6(N) No person shall hawk, peddle, sell or offer for sale goods/wares, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(15) §75.6(O) No person shall park vehicles, loiter, assemble, band or crowd together so to interfere with ingress or egress of others, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(16) §75.6(P) No person shall drive or move any vehicle on beach anytime without permit in writing issued by Chief of Police, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(17) §75.6(Q) No dogs or other animals on beach/water, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(18) §75.6(R) No kite flying during bathing hours, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

(19) §75.6(S) No fires on beach anytime, shall be amended to add a penalty for violation of the section in the amount of \$100.00.

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
