FLOOD INFORMATION:

The Margate Building Department is dedicated to solving the challenges of flood safety and awareness. Our City exists in a Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA), where storm flooding is likely and can be highly damaging. Flooding can be disastrous, but there are steps you can take to protect yourself and your property. Our Certified Floodplain Manager, Jim Galantino, is available to assist our residents with any flood questions or concerns, including information about flood hazards, base flood elevation, and flood protection, as well as access to flood maps. Jim Galantino may be reached at 609-822-1974, or by visiting our office located at 9001 Winchester Avenue. If requested, our CFM will visit a property to review its flood problem and explain ways to stop flooding or prevent flood damage. You may also find flood protection documents and flood maps on our website and at the Margate City Public Library.

FLOOD INSURANCE & ELEVATION CERTIFICATES:

Homeowners' insurance policies do not cover flood damage. Since the City of Margate participates in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) through the Federal Emergency Management Agency, you can purchase a separate flood insurance policy and receive a 25% reduction on your premium. To obtain flood insurance, your insurance company may request a flood elevation certificate to determine if your dwelling is above or below the Base Flood Elevation established by FEMA. The City of Margate does not prepare elevation certificates. Elevation certificates are prepared by locally licensed surveyors and submitted to the Margate Building Department as a requirement of the building permit process. Once submitted, our Certified Floodplain Manager will review them for accuracy and upload them to our website and to the ArcGIS online maps. PERMITS AND INSPECTIONS:

The Building Department accepts and reviews all building and zoning applications for any type of construction project. We highly recommend that if you have any questions about what permits are needed, on projects large or small, to contact us directly. Our staff is available to assist all homeowners and contractors with the permit and inspection process. Together, we can ensure the public health and safety of our community!
