

RESOLUTION #130-2023
AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER #1 (INCREASE)
SIGMUND S. RIMM RECREATIONAL COMPLEX BATTING CAGE
REPLACEMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey authorized Resolution #36-2023 on February 2, 2023 awarding a contract to Command Company, Inc., 1318 Antwerp Avenue, Egg Harbor City, N.J. 08215 as per their proposal for the Sigmund S. Rimm Recreational Complex Batting Cage Replacement in an amount of \$54,400.00; and

WHEREAS, Ed Dennis, City Engineer, prepared a letter dated May 15, 2023 regarding an increase in Change Order #1 that relates to support poles for netting due to relocation of batting cage resulting in an increase of \$9,537.28 and a new contract total of \$63,937.28; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified to the City Commissioners that there are sufficient funds in the amount not to exceed \$9,537.28 available under account #3-01-28-376-245 Recreation for this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey does hereby approve Change Order #1 (Increase) in the amount \$9,537.28 to the contract with Command Company, Inc., 1318 Antwerp Avenue, Egg Harbor City, N.J. 08215 to the new contract amount \$63,937.28.


