**APPROVAL TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND EXECUTE A
GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF
HOMELAND SECURITY FOR THE FY 2022
STATE AND LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM(SLCGP)**

WHEREAS, U. S. Department of Homeland Security and NJ Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness (NJOHSP) is offering a new program known as State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP); and

WHEREAS, the SLCGP Program aims to improve cybersecurity in state and local governments; and

WHEREAS, NJOHSP anticipates SLCGP funding to enhance assistance for resiliency to cyber threats; and

WHEREAS, the SLCGP's funding is tied to NJ Cybersecurity and Communication Integration Cell; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey carefully considers grant programs that assist the City in achieving projects and programs for the safety of the community; and

WHEREAS, actions taken through this Program will result in greater cybersecurity.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey formally authorizes the submission of the FY2022 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the U. S. Department of Homeland Security.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that contingent only on certification of matching funds by the CFO, the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the City of Margate City and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.


