A RESOLUTION REQUESTING PERMISSION FOR THE DEDICATION BY RIDER FOR STORM RECOVERY TRUST FUND PURSUANT TO P.L. 2013, c.271 and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-62.1

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonably accurate estimates in advance; and

WHEREAS, P.L.2013, c.271 and N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-62.1 provides for receipt of Storm Recovery Trust Funds by the municipality to provide for the operating costs to administer this act; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013, c.271 permits municipalities to lapse unexpended balances budgeted annually for snow removal and other storm recovery costs; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides the Director of Local Government Services may approve expenditures of monies by dedication by rider.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The Governing Body hereby requests permission of the Director of Local Government Services to pay expenditures for Storm Recovery created in accordance with the provisions of P.L. 2013, c271 as per N.J.S.A. 40:4-62.1.
- 2. That any unexpended balances from snow removal or storm recovery costs related appropriations be transferred to the established reserve.
- 3. The Municipal Clerk of the City of Margate City is hereby directed to forward two (2) certified copies of this Resolution to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
