

RESOLUTION #243-2022
AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY TO HIRE POLICE
OFFICERS FOR EMPLOYMENT UNDER SENATE BILL NO. 3672

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City, Atlantic County, State of New Jersey is a jurisdiction governed by Title 11A and the regulations and rules established under Title 4A of the Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City Police Department may hire individuals as police officers who may or may not have taken an open competitive examination for the title of police officers under the provisions of Senate Bill NO. 3672; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 3672 allows for individuals hired under the legislation to be hired as a provisional entry-level police officer, to an entry level law enforcement officer upon completion of the Full Basic Course for Police Officer Training within 9 months of a provisional entry-level appointment by the City of Margate City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City has duly established in writing, policies governing nepotism and governing conflicts of interest; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City believes that "Opting In" Provision to this program is in the interest of efficiency, expediency, diversity and promotes safety within the City of Margate City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, in the State of New Jersey that the hiring of police officers according to the provisions of Senate Bill No. 3672 authorizes the resolution, a copy of which shall be transmitted to the New Jersey Civil Service Commission


