

**RESOLUTION #249-2023**  
**AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT**  
**TO PROVIDE INTERIM ELECTRICAL SUBCODE AND INSPECTION SERVICES**  
**TO TRINITY CODE INSPECTIONS, LLC**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey has a need for Electrical Subcode and Inspection Services; and

**WHEREAS**, this contract is being considered without competitive bidding because it is a Professional Services Contract and is an exception to the Local Public Contracts Law, *N.J.S.A.* 40:11A-5 (1)(a)(i); and

**WHEREAS**, Trinity Code Inspections, LLC submitted a proposal for the interim dated October 18, 2023 at a rate of \$350/day in the amount not to exceed \$36,400.00; and

**WHEREAS**, Trinity Code Inspection, LLC will provide Interim Electrical Subcode and Inspection Services for 2 days per week for 52 weeks; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified to the City Commissioners that there are sufficient funds available under Construction Operating Expenses 3-01-22-195-301 \$11,200.00 and 4-01-22-195-301 \$25,200.00 is contingent upon sufficient funds being appropriated in the 2024 budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that a contract be awarded to Trinity Code Inspection, LLC as per the October 18, 2023 proposal.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Clerk is authorized to advertise the award of contract according to law in the Atlantic Press newspaper and to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the following:


