WHEREAS, the Local Property Acquisition Grant Program is a competitive grant program that deploys \$24 million by providing funding to eligible applicants for the acquisition of a vacant site, building, facility or a collection of properties, in order to facilitate and enable future redevelopment of the property; and

WHEREAS, this Program appropriates \$3 million for acquisition for strategic public use; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate carefully considers grant programs that assist the City in achieving projects and programs that are priorities for the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate wishes to apply to the NJEDA Local Property Acquisition Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Governing Body of the City of Margate formally approves a Local Property Acquisition Grant Program application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to submit an application to the New Jersey Economic Development Authority on behalf of the City of Margate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the grant agreement on behalf of the City of Margate and that their signature constitutes acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant agreement and approves the execution of the grant agreement.
