AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF AGREEMENT FOR SHARED MUNICIPAL COURT SERVICES FOR THE MUNICIPALITIES OF THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY AND THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1c provides in part that two or more municipalities, by ordinance or resolution, may agree to provide jointly for courtrooms, chambers, equipment, supplies and employees for their municipal courts and agree to appoint judges and administrators without establishing a joint municipal court. Where municipal courts share facilities in this manner, the identities of the individual courts shall continue to be expressed in the captions of orders and process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City and Borough of Longport had entered into an agreement for services in 2020 by Resolution #44-2020; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City desires to extend this shared services agreement for four additional months until April 30, 2021, under the same terms.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that the agreement entitled "Shared Services Agreement for Municipal Court Services" be and hereby extended until April 30, 2021.
