

RESOLUTION #36-2024

RESOLUTION CONFIRMING ACCEPTANCE OF WORK AS COMPLETE FY 2022 LAIF ATLANTIC AVENUE BICYCLE LANE PAINTING PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey authorized Resolution #203-2023 on September 7, 2023 awarding a contract to Traffic Lines, Inc., 5100 Asbury Road, Farmingdale, NJ 07727 as per their proposal for FY2022 Local Aid Infrastructure Fund Atlantic Avenue Bicycle Lane Painting Project in an amount of \$266,652.00; and

WHEREAS, Edward Dennis, City Engineer, has advised in a letter dated January 10, 2024 that the work is completed; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to establish a date of acceptance of work as complete and to authorize the submission of a Maintenance Bond by the aforesaid contractor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that it does hereby confirm and otherwise accept as complete the FY2022 Local Aid Infrastructure Fund Atlantic Avenue Bicycle Lane Painting Project in an amount of \$249,731.62.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the contractor, Traffic Lines, Inc., 5100 Asbury Road, Farmingdale, NJ 07727, is now hereby authorized to post a Maintenance Bond in said amount of \$249,731.62, which represents 100% of the total construction costs; said Bond to be in effect for a period of two years from the date of acceptance hereby established as of December 1, 2023.


