

RESOLUTION #38-2024

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING THE ALTERNATE FUND COMMISSIONER FOR THE MUNICIPAL JOINT INSURANCE FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey is a member of the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund, hereinafter referred to as the FUND; and

WHEREAS, the Bylaws of the FUND require that in the manner generally prescribed by law, each member shall appoint one (1) Alternate Fund commissioner to the Fund. The Alternate Fund Commissioner shall be either a member of the local unit's governing body or one of its employees and shall represent the Member in the absence of the Fund Commissioner; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 11:15-2.6 states that an Alternate Fund Commissioner who is a member of the appointing local unit's governing body, shall hold office for two years or for the remainder of his/her term of office as a member of the local unit's governing body, whichever shall be less; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 11:15-2.6 states that an Alternate Fund Commissioner who is an employee of the appointing member shall hold office at the pleasure of the member and can be removed by the member at any time without cause; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City recommends the appointment of Patrick Power to serve as Alternate Fund Commissioner in accordance with the FUND Bylaws.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Margate City that it does hereby appoint Patrick Power as Fund Commissioner to the Atlantic County Municipal Joint Insurance Fund.

This Resolution will take effect immediately and all other Resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


