

## RESOLUTION #43-2021

### AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER #2 (DECREASE) RECONSTRUCTION OF THURLOW AVENUE AND BAYSHORE DRIVE WEST

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, authorized Resolution #207-2019 on September 19, 2019 awarding a contract to Command Company, 1318 Antwerp Avenue, Egg Harbor City, NJ 08215 as per their proposal for the Reconstruction of Thurlow Avenue and Bayshore Drive West, in an amount of \$773,590.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners approved Resolution #73-2020, on April 2, 2020, for Change Order #1 that related to additional cost for cross drain on Thurlow Avenue in the amount of \$1,775.00, resulting in a new contract total of \$775,365.00; and

**WHEREAS**, City Engineer, Ed Dennis, has prepared a letter dated January 14, 2021 recommending approval of Change Order #2 that related to utility conflicts and additional drainage work on Bayshore Drive West in the net amount of \$(12,762.50), resulting in a new contract total of \$762,602.50.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, does hereby approve Change Order # 2 to the contract with Command Company, 1318 Antwerp Avenue, Egg Harbor City, NJ 08215 for the amended amount of \$762,602.50.


