

RESOLUTION #60-2021
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 2021 HORTON AMBULANCE
THROUGH HGAC BUY
COOPERATIVE PRICING SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12a and N.J.A.C. 5:34-7.29(c), may by resolution and without advertising for bids, purchase any goods or services under the HGAC BUY Cooperative Purchasing System; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City desire to purchase a 2021 Horton Ambulance through VCI Emergency Vehicle Specialists, an authorized vendor under the HGAC BUY Cooperative Purchasing System; and

WHEREAS, Fire Chief Daniel Adams, and Roger McLarnon, Qualified Purchasing Agent, recommend the purchasing of the 2021 Horton Ambulance, under #164501, to be awarded to VCI Emergency Vehicle Specialists, 43 Jefferson Avenue, Berlin, N.J. 08009 in the amount of \$214,432.00; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified to the Margate City Board of Commissioners that there are sufficient funds in the amount of \$214,432.00 available under Capital Ordinance #01-2021 account #C-04-55-986-902 for approval of this purchase.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey does hereby authorize the purchasing of the 2021 Horton Ambulance in the amount not to exceed \$214,432.00.


