

**RESOLUTION #112-2020  
CONFIRMING ACCEPTANCE OF  
WORK AS COMPLETE  
2018 BENSON AVENUE WATER TANK EXTERIOR PAINTING**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey previously adopted Resolution #229-2018 on November 1, 2018 which authorized the award of a contract to Allied Painting, Inc. 4 Larwin Road, Cherry Hill, NJ 08034 in the amount of \$715,320.00 for the 2018 Benson Avenue Water Tank Exterior Painting; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer, Ed Dennis, has advised in a letter dated May 28, 2020 that the work is complete; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body desires to establish a date of acceptance of work as complete and to authorize the submission of a Maintenance Bond by the aforesaid contractor.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that it does hereby confirm and otherwise accept as complete the 2018 Benson Avenue Water Tank Exterior Painting in the final contract amount of \$700,320.00.

**BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED** that the contractor, Allied Painting, Inc. 4 Larwin Road, Cherry Hill, NJ 08034 is now hereby authorized to post a Maintenance Bond in said amount of \$700,320.00 which represents 100% of the total construction costs; said Bond to be in effect for a period of two years from the date of acceptance hereby established as of May 6, 2020.
