DISPOSAL INFORMATION

BULKY WASTE: One (1) item per trash day including furniture and mattresses. Carpet must be cut into 4' lengths, rolled and tied (1 roll=1 bulk item). No metals, construction waste, televisions or electronics.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP-OFF

- See front for dates and location.
- Proof of residency is required - driver's license, tax bill, etc.
- Containers will not be returned, no exceptions. Bring items in a throwaway container (such as a cardboard box).
- Container sizes cannot exceed 5 gallons. No exceptions.
- Maximum quantity is 20 gallons and/or 200 lbs. dry weight.
- NO materials from commercial establishments.
