#### **ORDINANCE #21-2018**

# AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A PRIVATE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS A PORTION OF BLOCK 528 LOT 2.03 ON THE TAX MAP OF THE CITY OF MARGATE TO THE CONTIGUOUS OWNER THERETO PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.2

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City owns a certain tract or parcel of land known as Block 528, Lot 2.03 as shown on the official tax map of the City of Margate City; and

WHEREAS, a certain portion of Block 528, Lot 2.03 contiguous to Block 528, Lots 1, 1.01, 2, 2.01, 3, and 3.01 and having dimensions of 70 feet by 25 feet and containing 1,750sq. feet which property is not needed for public use (hereinafter the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Barbary Coast Marina, LLC (hereinafter "Barbary Coast" and hereafter referred to as "Contiguous Landowner") is the owner of lands contiguous to the Property known as Block 528, portion of Lot 2.03 as shown on the official tax map of the City of Margate City and being commonly known as 9401Amherst Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Contiguous Landowner desires to purchase a portion of the Property consisting of 70feet by 25feet (being a total of 1,750 sq. feet) landward of an existing bulkhead and said Contiguous Landowner has previously received zoning approval from the Margate Planning Board which approval is memorialized in the Decision and Resolution 21-2018 which approval specifies, among other things, that the Applicant shall reconstruct 175 feet of linear bulkhead and will extend a public pedestrian promenade or walkway along the waterfront which area will be maintained by Contiguous Land Owner or his successors in interest; and

WHEREAS, Contiguous Landowner will pay all costs of bulkhead improvement and other site improvements as required by the Margate City Planning Board approval, Resolution #21-2018 along the waterfront area of Contiguous Landowners property; and

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate said land is of no further use for public purpose and is not needed for public use and should be disposed of in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.2 by sale to the contiguous landowner upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of Margate, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. There is hereby authorized for private sale to the Contiguous Landowners, Barbary Coast, LLC, pursuant to the provisions of *N.J.S.A.* 40A:12-13, a portion of Block 528, Lot 2.03 described in the legal description in a Land Conveyance Plan and legal description attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof, constituting a strip of land 70 feet by 25 feet, and containing a total of 1,750sq. feet, together with all appurtenant rights and privileges. The property to be conveyed shall be subdivided from the remainder of Lot 528, Block 2.03\_\_\_\_\_ by the City prior to conveyance.

SECTION 2: The consideration for this sale shall be the construction of approximately 175\_\_\_\_\_ linear feet of replacement bulkhead as approved by the City Engineer within 24" waterward of the existing deteriorated bulkhead fronting the parcel.

SECTION 3: The cost estimate of construction including 175' of bulkhead, demolition, asphalt, concrete and miscellaneous expenses of public improvements is attached hereto as Exhibit B and amounts to a total \$443,681.70 which meets or exceeds the fair market value of the property.

SECTION 4. The public shall have access along the waterfront in the subject parcel which area is referred to as the public pedestrian promenade or walkway along the waterfront and shall be maintained by Contiguous Landowners or its successors in interest.

SECTION 5. A contract with the Contiguous Landowner containing the terms herein and as provided by the City Solicitor, is hereby authorized and shall be executed by the Mayor of the

City of Margate and the Contiguous Landowner incorporating all essential terms and conditions of the conveyance.

**SECTION 6:** The Mayor of the City of Margate shall execute and deliver to the City Solicitor, a Bargain and Sale Deed with Covenants Against Grantor's Acts, in proper form for recording in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, conveying the Property together with appropriate Affidavit of Title, which deed is to be held in escrow by the City Solicitor pending completion of the bulkhead and approval of all construction by the City Engineer. Construction shall be performed no later than twelve (12) months from the passage of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 7:** Settlement on conveyance of the Property shall occur at the Margate City Hall or such other place as agreed to by the parties.

**SECTION 8:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

**SECTION 9:** This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

**SECTION 10:** Terms and Conditions of Sale. It is acknowledged and understood as to specific terms and conditions, that an easement allowing pedestrian access shall be authorized

#### **AGREEMENT**

BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY AND BARBARY COAST MARINA, LLC PROVIDING FOR THE EXCHANGE OF PROPERTY (PORTION OF LOT 2.03 OF BLOCK 528) FOR REPLACEMENT OF A PORTION OF THE BEACH THOROUGHFARE / AMHERST AVENUE BULKHEAD

#### **BACKGROUND**

Barbary Coast Marina, LLC (hereinafter "Barbary") is the fee simple owner of certain property covered by the waters of Beach Thoroughfare identified on the City of Margate (the "City") Tax Map as Block 528, Lots 2.02 and 2.03 situated waterward of what is commonly referred to as the "Amherst Avenue Bulkhead" (the "Barbary Property"). The Barbary Property has 175 feet of frontage along the bulkhead, is 275 feet deep, and has been approved for the development of a mixed use building to include commercial office space and two residential units along with a marina and associated marina structure.

The Barbary Property is bounded at its southerly property line by 175 feet of bulkhead which is owned by the City of Margate. The City also owns the lands upland of the bulkhead identified as Lot 2.03 in Block 528 on the City Tax Map (the "City Property"). The City Property and the Barbary Property are separated only by the City bulkhead.

The City bulkhead is in need of replacement at an estimated cost to the City of \$400,000 to \$500,000. The approval received by Barbary from the Margate Planning Board includes, as referenced, a marina and mixed use commercial / residential building which would benefit from

having dedicated parking spaces on the upland immediately adjacent to the Barbary Property identified as a portion of Lot 2.03 in Block 528.

In light of the significant cost to the City of replacing the 175 feet of bulkhead which bounds the Barbary Property, the City has agreed to convey to Barbary a portion of Lot 2.03 in Block 528 which Barbary can then use as parking, building access, trash area and storage for its development. The lands to be conveyed by the City to Barbary are shown more specifically on the Land Conveyance Plan attached hereto and made a part hereof prepared by Arthur W. Ponzio Co. & Associates, Inc. dated February 28, 2018, revised March 29, 2018, and identifies a portion of Lot 2.03 in Block 528 being 70 feet by 25 feet with 1,750 square feet of land area (the "Parking Parcel").

In exchange for the City conveying the Parking Parcel to Barbary, Barbary has agreed to replace the City's bulkhead along the entire frontage of the Barbary Property, being 175 feet of bulkhead. The bulkhead shall be replaced at the sole cost and expense of Barbary and pursuant to City specifications.

Accordingly, Barbary desires to:

- (i) Acquire fee simple title to the 1,750 square foot Parking Parcel;
- (ii) Commence and pay for all costs of construction for the new replacement bulkhead extending 175 feet along the southerly frontage of the Barbary Property and situated along the northerly property line of a portion of Lot 2.03 in Block 528 owned by the City. The bulkhead shall be replaced at the sole cost and expense of Barbary, but designed by the City and constructed in accordance with

the plan approved as part of Barbary's CAFRA Permit for the bulkhead and marina portion of Barbary's development project;

(iii) Receive title to the 1,750 square foot Parking Parcel upon completion and acceptance of the bulkhead by the City Engineer.

# The City has determined that:

- (i) It is beneficial for the City to be relieved of the financial burden of maintaining, repairing and replacing the bulkhead which fronts the Barbary Property, but is owned by the City;
- (ii) The 1,750 square foot Parking Parcel can be deeded to Barbary as it will continue to provide parking and Barbary has agreed to restrict the Parking Parcel for the exclusive use of parking, building access, trash and storage by the Barbary property owners;
- (iii) The value of Barbary's assumption of the construction of the 175 linear feet of new bulkhead and acceptance of title with the responsibility to maintain, repair and replace the bulkhead running the width of the Barbary Property exceeds the fair market value of the 1,750 square foot Parking Parcel.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the parties hereto, Barbary and the City on this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_\_, 2018, agree as follows:

# Incorporation of "Background":

All of the "Background" shall be and is hereby incorporated in the body of this Agreement.

# 2. Barbary's Obligations:

- a. Barbary shall commence construction of approximately 175 linear feet of bulkhead, said bulkhead replacing the deteriorated bulkhead located along a portion of Lot 2.03 in Block 528 extending along the frontage of Barbary's Property. Construction of the bulkhead shall be in accordance with the City Engineer's design and specification and shall be constructed with City Engineer approval upon completion. Barbary shall be responsible for all permits and construction costs.
- b. Barbary shall obtain a title examination and confirm in writing to the City Solicitor on behalf of the City of Margate City, that such title to that portion of Lot 2.03 in Block 528 being conveyed is acceptable to Barbary. In the event title is not acceptable, this Agreement and all of its terms and obligations shall cease and become null and void with no further responsibility or liability between the parties.
- c. Barbary shall, upon receipt of title to the parcel, record a deed of consolidation for the Parking Parcel and Barbary's Lots 2 and 2.01 in Block 528 so as to consolidate the Parking Parcel into the larger Barbary parcel.
- d. Barbary shall accept title to the Parking Parcel, but restrict the Parking Parcel for use as parking, building access, trash and storage only for Barbary's development.

### 3. City's Obligations:

- a. The City shall approve of the Bulkhead Replacement Plan being relied upon by Barbary for replacement of the City bulkhead.
- b. The City shall inspect the bulkhead to confirm compliance with those specifications required of the City and by the City.
- c. The City shall cause the subdivision of that portion of Lot 2.03 in Block 528 (the Parking Parcel), to permit the conveyance of the Parking Parcel to Barbary, but retain ownership of the remainder of Lot 2.03 in Block 528.
- 4. **Time of Completion.** Barbary shall be obligated to diligently pursue completion of construction of the bulkhead. Barbary shall have 365 days from full execution and delivery of this Agreement to complete construction and to have same certified as acceptable by the City. Failure to timely complete the construction shall authorize the City to declare this Agreement null and void and of no further force and effect. If construction is in the process of completion, for good cause and at the sole discretion of the City, the time period for completion may be extended.
