RESOLUTION No.180-2015 - AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN ADDENDEM TO INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF ATLANTIC, THE CITY OF VENTNOR CITY AND THE ATLANTIC COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY REGARDING TO THE VENTNOR GARDENS STORM WATER STATION

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified to the City Commissioners that there are sufficient funds in the amount of \$47,677.26 available under Coastal Resiliency NFWF – State Share G-01-41-705-001 for the award of this contract.
