The Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held on the above date at 4:35 p.m. at the Margate City Hall, 1 South Washington Avenue, Margate, NJ 08402. The meeting began with a flag salute and roll call: Mayor Michael Becker, Commissioner John Amodeo and Commissioner Maury Blumberg were present. Roger McLarnon, Johanna Casey, Rich Deaney, and Scott Abbott were also present. # AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY TO ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE PRICING AGREEMENT WITH SOUTH JERSEY POWER COOPERATIVE FOR NATURAL GAS

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11 authorizes contracting units to establish a Cooperative Pricing System and to enter into Cooperative Pricing Agreement for its administration; and

WHERAS, the City of Margate City in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey is a member of the Atlantic County Cooperative System, a participating member of the South Jersey Power Cooperative (SJPC); and

WHEREAS, the South Jersey Power Cooperative is a cooperative of many South Jersey municipalities and government entities who band together through a bidding process to obtain lower prices for goods and services to its participating entities; and

WHEREAS, the County of Camden, is hereinafter referred to as the "Lead Agency" for the South Jersey Power Cooperative, received bids on behalf of the South Jersey Power Cooperative members for the procurement of natural gas supply services; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2019 the lead agency awarded through Resolution #2019-00738 natural gas supply services for a thirty six month period commencing December 1, 2019 and ending November 30, 2022 to UGI Energy Services, the lowest responsible bidder that has extended cooperative pricing for natural gas supply services with a fixed price of \$4.176/dth; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, is duly authorized to purchase natural gas supply services thru the lead agency, the County of Camden; and
