REGULAR MEETING MINUTES CITY COMMISSION – MARGATE CITY

JULY 2, 2020

THE PRESS AND THE STAR LEDGER WERE NOTIFIED OF THIS MEETING AND A COPY OF THE SAME WAS POSTED ON THE BULLETIN BOARD AND THE MUNICIPAL WEBSITE.

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held on the above date at 4:00 p.m. at Margate City's Historic City Hall Court Room, 1 South Washington Avenue, Margate, NJ.

Johanna Casey, City Clerk, reads the statement of compliance followed with the flag salute and roll call: Mayor Michael Becker, Commissioner John Amodeo and Commissioner Maury Blumberg were present. Chief Matt Hankinson, Chief Daniel Adams, Frank Ricciotti, Fred Verna, Johanna Casey, Scott Abbott and Rich Deaney were also present.

Mayor Becker: Announces that the meeting of July 16, 2020 will be held via telecommunication along with the ability to attend.

Department Reports:

Frank Ricciotti: Weeds in the park next to the library are being taken care of by the contracted landscaping company. New water lines are being located along with existing water lines being fixed, and more trash cans are available along the bayfront at Amherst Avenue. Speaks on playgrounds reopening. Speaks on the steps being taken by the public works department to assist in the prevention of COVID-19. Working on davits on the beach. Speaks on what is being done to maintain the beaches. The amount of trash being collected this year is greater than previous years. Water usage is also above average. New water and sewer lines have been installed at new construction sites. Repairs have been made to some water meter picks and the sprinkler system at the ballfield. A collapsed sewer at Cedar Grove Avenue was repaired.

Chief Adams: Gives a synopsis of the past six months and the action plans initiated to prevent the spread of COVID-19. All twelves beaches are open. Compliments Beach Patrol Chief Greg Smallwood on the job he is doing. Speaks on the cooperation between all departments over the past few months.

Scott Abbott: Nothing to report.

The minutes from the June 18, 2020 Regular Meeting were approved as read on motion by Commissioner Blumberg, seconded by Commissioner Amodeo with a vote three ayes.

Len Goldberg, 9100 Atlantic Ave.: Speaks on issues that would arise if a high rise is built.
