REGULAR MEETING MINUTES CITY COMMISSION – MARGATE CITY

APRIL 1, 2021

MARGATE CITY, NEW JERSEY

THE ATLANITC CITY PRESS AND THE STAR LEDGER WERE NOTIFIED OF THIS MEETING AND A COPY OF THE SAME WAS POSTED ON THE BULLETIN BOARD AND THE MUNICIPAL WEBSITE.

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held on the above date at 4:00 p.m. via telecommunication.

Johanna Casey, City Clerk: Reads the statement of compliance and the procedure for a telecommunication meeting, followed with the flag salute and roll call is taken: Mayor Michael Becker, Commissioner John Amodeo and Commissioner Maury Blumberg were present. Fred Verna, Chief Matt Hankinson, Lisa McLaughlin, Ed Dennis, Johanna Casey, and Rich Deaney were present. The minutes from the March 18, 2021 Regular Meeting was approved as read on motion by Commissioner Amodeo, seconded by Commission Blumberg, with a vote three ayes.

Engineering Report:

Ed Dennis: Gives an update on eleven municipal projects that are either finished, in construction or nearing completion: Reconstruction of Atlantic Avenue, Bayshore Drive West, Beach Access at Argyle Avenue, Amherst Avenue Phase I from Douglas Avenue to Clarendon Avenue, 2019 & 2020 Curb and Gutter Program, Benson Avenue Water Tank Interior Painting, Amherst Avenue Promenade, Firehouse #1 Upgrades, Firehouse #2 Addition, Ventnor Avenue Streetscape and Ventnor Avenue and Washington Avenue Intersection, and Atlantic Avenue Road Diet. The city has secured over 1.2 Million in grant money to cover these projects. Upcoming City projects: City wide dredging permits, 2021 Curb and Gutter Project, work to be done on Well #5, State Aid Amherst Avenue Phase 2, Road Program for Gladstone, Jefferson, Clermont, and Brunswick Avenues, and the Police Department parking lot, to build upon the GIS data base, the replacement of some water meters, and the continuation of renovations on City Hall.

Commissioner Amodeo: Inquires about the status of the Amherst Avenue Phase I Project.

Ed Dennis: Speaks on the status of the Amherst Avenue Phase I Project.

Mayor Becker: Inquires about the estimated time frame for completion of the Amherst Avenue Phase I Project.

Ed Dennis: Depending on what is completed this spring, this project may be put on hold during the summer, then completed in fall 2021. Also addressing concerns from residents in the area of this project.

Public Comment:

Rick Klaussen, 9100 Atlantic Avenue: States he spoke on this matter back in December 2020. Following up on what is being done about kids being on the beach late at night and being loud. Inquiries about the City having a curfew.

Chief Hankinson: Speaks on how the police plan to handle kids on the beach at night and the curfew.

Seeing that there were no additional comments, a motion to close Public Comments was put forth by Commissioner Amodeo, seconded by Commissioner Blumberg, with a vote of three ayes.

A motion to introduce **Ordinance** #06-2021, an Ordinance amending the flow of traffic on Amherst Avenue from Washington to Coolidge Avenue to one way, was put forth by Commissioner Amodeo, Seconded by Commissioner Blumberg, with a vote of three ayes.

Johanna Casey: Reads Ordinance #05-2021 by title.

A motion to Adopt **Ordinance** #05-2021, an Ordinance providing for agreement between the City of Margate City and the Borough of Longport for shared municipal court services pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1C, was put forth by Commissioner Amodeo, Seconded by Commissioner Blumberg, with a vote of three ayes.

ORDINANCE #05–2021 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SHARED MUNICIPAL COURT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY AND THE BOROUGH OF LONGPORT FOR SHARED MUNICIPAL COURT SERVICES PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1C

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 2B:12-1c provides in part that two or more municipalities, by Ordinance or Resolution, may agree to provide jointly for courtrooms, chambers, equipment, supplies and employees for their municipal courts and agree to appoint judges and administrators without establish a joint municipal court. Where municipal courts share facilities in this manner, the identities of the individual courts shall continue to be expressed in the captions of orders and process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City and the Borough of Longport have previously established a Shared Services Agreement between the municipalities for the term beginning February 1, 2020 ending on December 31, 2020 as outlined in Resolution #44-2020, which time period was extended from January 1, 2021 through May 1, 2021 as outlined in Resolution #29-2021; and

WHEREAS, both Municipalities wish to continue to share the services of the municipal courts and a written Agreement specifying the terms and conditions of said Agreement has been prepared and has been reviewed by each Municipality, which Agreement is entitled "Shared Services Agreement for Municipal Court Services" a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, which Agreement extends the shared services for a period of five (5) years commencing on May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2026 for consideration as outlined is said Shared Services Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of Margate, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein as if set forth at length.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the attached Agreement for Shared Municipal Court Services to establish a shared Municipal court on behalf of the City of Margate City with the Borough of Longport.

SECTION 3. If any portion of this Ordinances is declared invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remaining portions of the Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or portions thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent such inconsistency.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

RESOLUTION # 67-2021 AUTHORIZING SELF-EXAMINATION OF 2021 MUNICIPAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-78b has authorized the Local Finance Board to adopt rules that permit municipalities in sound fiscal condition to assume the responsibility, normally granted to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, of conducting the annual budget examination; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:30-7 was adopted by the Local Finance Board on February 11, 1997; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.2 through 7.5, the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey has been declared eligible to participate in the program by the Division of Local Government Services, and the Chief Financial Officer has determined that the local government meets the necessary conditions to participate in the program for the 2021 budget year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Margate City that in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.6a & 7.6b and based upon the Chief Financial Officer's certification, the governing body has found the budget has met the following requirements:

- 1. That with reference to the following items, the amounts have been calculated pursuant to law and appropriated as such in the budget:
 - a. Payment of interest and debt redemption charges
 - b. Deferred charges and statutory expenditures
 - c. Cash deficit of preceding year
 - d. Reserve for uncollected taxes
 - e. Other reserves and non-disbursement items
 - f. Any inclusions of amounts required for school purposes.
- 2. That the provisions relating to limitation on increases of appropriations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.2 and appropriations for exceptions to limits on appropriations found at N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.3 et seq., are fully met (complies with CAP law).
- 3. That the budget is in such form, arrangement, and content as required by the Local Budget Law and N.J.A.C. 5:30-4 and 5:30-5.
 - 4. That pursuant to the Local Budget Law:
 - a. All estimates of revenue are reasonable, accurate and correctly stated
 - b. Items of appropriation are properly set forth
 - c. In itemization, form, arrangement and content, the budget will

permit the exercise of the comptroller function within the municipality.


- 5. The budget and associated amendments have been introduced and publicly advertised in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Local Budget Law, except that failure to meet the deadlines of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5 shall not prevent such certification.
 - 6. That all other applicable statutory requirements have been fulfilled.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution will be forwarded to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services upon adoption.

RESOLUTION #74-2021 CITY OF MARGATE RESOLUTION OPPOSING NJDEP'S PROPOSED COASTAL REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) is planning to adopt new land use regulations that will likely have a significant negative economic impact to Margate property owners; and

WHEREAS, the regulations known as Protecting Against Climate Threats (PACT) propose to require five feet of freeboard above the base flood elevation for new construction in the flood zone. Elevating new and substantially improved homes an additional five feet may be prohibitively expensive and not reasonably based on need; and

WHEREAS, historically when NJDEP issues new rules they have been in alignment with corresponding legislation. In this case there is no legislation that has authorized the NJDEP to require more stringent requirements than the federal regulation that are now in place; and

WHEREAS, the proposed NJDEP freeboard requirement is based on sea level rise projections for the year 2100. Municipalities are required to prepare Master Plans with 20 or 30 year planning horizon, and the State should use the same time horizon that they require municipalities to use; and

WHEREAS, the science behind these 80 year projections has been questioned by many;

and

WHEREAS, when municipalities impose new regulations, the State requires that they must be consistent with the adopted Master Plan after public input and revisions. In this case, NJDEP is proposing significant regulatory changes without a completed Resiliency Plan. The New Jersey Coastal Resiliency Plan is being prepared and has yet to be released or subject to public input or adoption; and

WHEREAS, there has been no major discussion concerning the magnitude of the economic impact of the proposed regulations or how to assist residents who will be negatively impacted. NJDEP must engage in a meaningful, economic impact analysis, and not simply rely on an analysis of potential impacts from future, projected climate change related threats.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Margate, New Jersey that it opposes the Protecting Against Climate Threats (PACT) regulations as drafted, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the sea level rise projections being used by NJDEP be subjected to a scholarly peer review prior to commencing the rule making process, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the NJDEP regulations be based on 20 or 30 year timeframe and adjusted over time to the actual impacts of sea level rise decade by decade rather than based on an 80-year projection, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that NJDEP ensure that policy officials and stakeholders have an opportunity to review and evaluate the New Jersey Coastal Resiliency Plan before proposing rules that seek to solve many issues the report will purportedly identify, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the NJDEP seek the counsel from an independent economist to considering potential economic impacts prior to commencing the rule making process, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the NJDEP provide follow the same practices as FEMA and provide detailed maps so that communities and residents can clearly understand how these regulations effect specific properties.

3. VACATION.

Manghan shall receive twenty (20) vacation days annually.

4. SICK TIME.

Manghan shall be entitled to fifteen (15) sick days annually. For each year in which Manghan has 100 days accumulated as of December 1 of that year he shall be entitled to sell back up to 3 days at his daily base rate of pay.

5. HOLIDAYS.

Manghan shall be off from duty on all City recognized holidays for non-union managerial employees. If he is required to work for any reason, he shall do so without compensation but may take compensatory time off within the pay period.

6. OVERTIME.

Manghan shall not be entitled to receive and shall not be eligible to receive overtime pay or any other pay or time off in his capacity as Tax Assessor unless provided for in this contract.

7. HOURS:

Manghan shall work the hours required to perform the duties of the position but shall usually be expected to be in the City office Monday – Thursday 8:30 am - 4:30 pm and to work from his home office as needed on Fridays and weekends.

BASE PAY

Manghan shall be paid a base pay of \$89,000.00 prorated for 2021 as of April 1, 2021 and a base pay of \$94,000.00 for 2022, \$99,000.00 for 2023 and \$104,000 for 2024.

9. FULLY BARGAINED AGREEMENT.

This agreement contains all of the promises and understandings of Manghan and the City and there are no other agreements or understandings, except as set forth herein. This agreement and the obligations contained herein may be amended only by subsequent written agreement signed by Manghan and the City, with the approval of the governing body.

10. GOVERNING LAW.

This agreement shall be covered by and considered and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey without regard to any principles of choice law that may otherwise be applicable.
