WHEREAS, Atlantic County Cooperative Purchasing System received and opened bids on Friday, June 14, 2019 for Rock Salt Supply Service for the Atlantic County Cooperative; and

WHEREAS, Atlantic Salt, Inc., 134 Middle Street, #210, Lowell, MA 01852 was the lowest responsible bidder for the Rock Salt bid at \$71.50 per ton. The City of Margate City, in Atlantic County, State of New Jersey, hereby acknowledges and accepts this bid rate for a service period of ten months, commencing October 5, 2021 thru May 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the Participating Members, Atlantic County Cooperative Purchasing System has executed a master agreement with Atlantic Salt, Inc., 134 Middle Street, #210, Lowell, MA 01852 for the needs of the participating members of Atlantic County Cooperative Purchasing System as described above commencing on the above specified dates; and
