Statement of Compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act:

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held on the above date at 4:00 p.m. in person at Margate Historic City Hall, 1 South Washington Avenue, Margate, NJ.

Johanna Casey, City Clerk: Reads the statement of compliance, followed with the flag salute and roll call is taken: Mayor Michael Becker, Commissioner John Amodeo and Commissioner Maury Blumberg were present. Chief Dan Adams, Captain Ron Kashon, Lisa McLaughlin, Roger McLarnon, Ed Dennis, Rich Deane, Johanna Casey and Scott Abbott, Esquire were also present.

Approval of Minutes:

The minutes from the November 17, 2022 Workshop/Capital Meeting and Regular Meeting were approved as read on motion by Commissioner Amodeo, seconded by Commissioner Blumberg, with a vote of two ayes. Mayor Becker abstained.

ORDINANCE NO. 25-2022
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 132 ARTICLE III FEES AND RATES FOR RECREATION OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF MARGATE CITY, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of Margate, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey that the following be AMENDED to Chapter 132 FEES Article III Fees and Rates for Recreation Department:

SECTION 1. Margate City Code **Chapter 132 §132-7** is hereby amended to the following sections:

ARTICLE III. FEES & RATES FOR RECREATION DEPARTMENT

3. The City of Margate may impose additional labor and cleaning charges at standard hourly rates beyond rental fees for labor intensive functions at the Martin Bloom Pavilion
- B. Stage Rentals Including Set-up
- 1. Small Size (8 x 16 with cover) \$1,000*
 - 2. Large Size (12 x 24 with cover) \$1,600*
- C. Outdoor Playing Fields
- 1. Lined/Prepared Field \$50 per game*
 - 2. Non Lined Field \$25/hr*
- D. Basketball Courts
- 1. Single Court Rental \$300 up to 4 hours*
- *\$50 for each additional hour
