Department Reports:

Mr. Verna: Staff is working hard. Project 25 Radio upgrade will be up and running by next week. Thanks to Deputy Chief Adams for all his knowledge and help.

Mr. Deaney: Employee Handbook addresses nepotism. Joint Insurance Fund implements policies as to Employee Law. Ethical Standards is addressed as an Ordinance in Margate City Code Book.
