

ORDINANCE NO. 11– 2015
AMENDING CHAPTER 127, DUMPSTERS OF THE CODE OF THE
CITY OF MARGATE CITY, COUNTY OF ATLANTIC AND
STATE OF NEW JERSEY

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of the City of Margate in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Margate City Code Chapter 127-2 “Permit required; use regulations”, shall be amended to read as follows with all other sections not mentioned to remain the same:

§127-2 Permit required; use regulations

- F. Prior to any dumpster/construction container or PODS container permit issuance, the person or entity applying for the permit shall be required to have the designated individual from the Public Works Department or other designated Municipal entity, confirm on the application for permit that the applicant has been provided a written copy of all Margate recycling information pertaining to what is permitted to be placed in the dumpster/construction container or PODS container.

SECTION 2. Margate City Code Chapter 127-3. “Issuance of permits; display” shall be amended to read as follows with all other sections not mentioned to remain the same:

§127-3 Issuance of permits; display

- A. All permits required by this article shall be in writing and shall be issued by the City of Margate Police Department. The City of Margate Police Department shall issue the permit if it appears that the applicant has the right and the need to use a dumpster/construction container or PODS container. Prior to the issuance of such a permit, the Police Department shall determine if the proposed use of the dumpster/construction container or PODS container will constitute a traffic and/or safety hazard.

SECTION 3. Margate City Code Chapter 127-4. “Fees” shall be amended to read as follows:

§127-4 Fees

The fee payable for permits issued under this article shall be \$50.00 for each dumpster/construction container or PODS container for a period of 15 days. The permit may be renewed for additional fifteen-day periods for a fee of \$25.00 per renewal.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with any terms of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
