

RESOLUTION #113-2021
AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER #1 (INCREASE)
MARGATE CITY POLICE STATION EXTERIOR FAÇADE AND
ROOF RESTORATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey authorized Resolution #67-2020 on March 18, 2020 awarding a contract to Roof Management, Inc., 1627 Wyckoff Rd., Wall, NJ 07727 as per their proposal for Margate City Police Station Exterior Façade and Roof Restoration Project, in an amount of \$274,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Purchasing Agent, Roger McLarnon, has prepared a letter dated April 29, 2021 regarding an increase in Change Order #1 that relates to additional work to fabricate and install a fascia enclosure along the perimeter of the low-sloped roof the amount of \$6,830.00 resulting in a new contract total of \$280,830.00; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified to the Margate City Board of Commissioners that there are sufficient funds in the amount of \$280,830.00 available under Ord 07-2019 account: C-04-55-984-902 account for approval of this change order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey does hereby approve Change Order # 1(Increase) to the contract with Roof Management, Inc., 1627 Wyckoff Rd. Wall, NJ 07727 to the new contract amount \$280,830.00.
