REGARDING CITY OF MARGATE CITY ZONING AND CODE RELIEF FOR BUSINESSES DURING PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City Board of Commissioners desires to provide zoning and code relief to assist existing local businesses with valid mercantile licenses which support primary residences, second homeowners and guests to the City of Margate City; and

WHEREAS, the intent of this relief is to help businesses restore revenue after being required to be shuttered or reduced business during the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to further supplement Ordinance 203-Outdoor Dining and Resolution #39-2022 by the extension of allowable outdoor service so that service will stop by 10:00 p.m. and all outdoor music shall cease by 9:00 p.m.; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Margate City Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the extension of outdoor service as authorized by Resolution #39-2022, so that said service may continue to 10:00 p.m. each night conditioned upon outdoor music ceasing at 10:00 p.m. each night.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this change in the hours of service shall be in effect immediately and applicable to all eateries and businesses utilizing public rights of way and parking areas and that said relief is temporary until October 31, 2022.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption
