Nolt, Inc., 53 Cross Keys Road, Berlin, NJ 08009 is now hereby authorized to post a Maintenance Bond in said amount of \$236,015.51, which represents 100% of the total construction costs; said Bond to be in effect for a period of one years from the date of acceptance hereby established as of May 24, 2022.
