

RESOLUTION #143-2021

REQUEST OF DLGS FOR APPROVAL TO INSERT GRANT MONEY

WHEREAS, a grant from the County of Atlantic in the amount of FIVE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE DOLLARS AND NINE CENTS (\$5,231.09) has become available to the City of Margate City; and

WHEREAS, NJSA 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any county or municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the Director may also approve the insertion of an appropriation for the equal amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate, in the County of Atlantic, New Jersey hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an item of revenue in the budget of the year 2021 in the sum of \$5,231.09, which is now available as a revenue from Municipal Alliance on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the like sum of \$5,231.09 is hereby appropriated under the caption Municipal Alliance on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVEN DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$1,307.77) representing the amount required for the municipality's share of the aforementioned undertaking or improvement appears in the budget of the year 2021 under the caption Matching Funds for Grants and is hereby appropriated under the caption of Municipal Alliance on Alcoholism and Drug Abuse Local Match.


