

RESOLUTION #146-2021
AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER #1 (INCREASE)
FY2020 STATE AID ATLANTIC AVENUE ROAD DIET

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey authorized Resolution #75-2021 on April 1, 2021 awarding a contract to Zone Striping, Inc., 718 Jacob Harris Lane, PO Box 568, Glassboro, NJ 08028 as per their proposal for the FY2020 State Aid Atlantic Avenue Road Diet, in an amount of \$233,333.77; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer, Edward Dennis, of Remington & Vernick Engineers, submitted a letter dated June 21, 2021 regarding an increase in Change Order #1 that relates to Additional Striping in the amount of \$165.30 and Time Extension of 30 days, resulting in a new contract total of \$233,499.07 and completion date of July 5, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified to the Margate City Board of Commissioners that there are sufficient funds in the amount of \$165.30 available under C-04-55-986-907 account for approval of this change order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey does hereby approve Change Order #1 to the contract with Zone Striping, Inc., 718 Jacob Harris Lane, PO Box 568, Glassboro, NJ 08028 to the new contract amount \$233,499.07 with the completion date of July 5, 2021 for FY2020 State Aid Atlantic Avenue Road Diet.

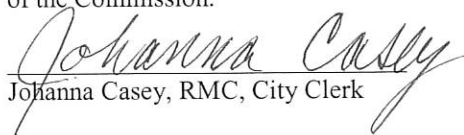
