

RESOLUTION #151-2020

AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER #3 (DECREASE) FY 2016 SAFE ROUTE TO SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey authorized Resolution #183-2019, on August 1, 2019 awarding the contract to L. Feriozzi Concrete Company, 3031 Sunset Avenue, Atlantic City, NJ 08401, as per their proposal for the FY 2016 Safe Route to School Infrastructure Plan Project, in an amount of \$417,753.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners approved resolution #225-2019, on October 17, 2019, for Change Order #1 that related to tree removal in the amount of \$4,400.00, resulting in a new contract total of \$422,153.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners approved resolution #244-2019, on November 7, 2019 for Change Order #2 that related to additional concrete to address field conditions and to perform installations and additional concrete work requested by the city in the amount of \$17,469.00, resulting in a new contract total of \$439,622.00; and

WHEREAS, City Engineer, Ed Dennis, has prepared a letter dated July 22, 2020 recommending approval of Change Order #3 that related to final as built quantities in the amount of \$(9,812.65), resulting in a new contract total of \$429,809.35.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey, does hereby approve Change Order #3 to the contract with L. Feriozzi Concrete Company, 3031 Sunset Avenue, Atlantic City, NJ 08401.


