BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the contractor, Command Company, 1318 Antwerp Avenue, Egg Harbor City, NJ 08215 is now hereby authorized to post a Maintenance Bond in said amount of \$727,930.24 which represents 100% of the total construction costs; said Bond to be in effect for a period of two years from the date of acceptance hereby established as of June 18, 2021.
