

RESOLUTION #173-2021

**RESOLUTION CONFIRMING ACCEPTANCE OF
WORK AS COMPLETE
BENSON AVENUE WATER TANK INTERIOR PAINTING PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey previously adopted Resolution #247-2020 on December 3, 2020 which authorized the award of a contract to Allied Painting, Inc., 4 Larwin Road, Cherry Hill, NJ 08034, as per their bid proposal in an amount of \$550,225.00 for the 2020 Benson Avenue Water Tank Interior Painting Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer, Ed Dennis has advised in a letter dated August 16, 2021 that the work is completed; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to establish a date of acceptance of work as complete and to authorize the submission of a Maintenance Bond by the aforesaid contractor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that it does hereby confirm and otherwise accept as complete the 2020 Benson Avenue Water Tank Interior Painting Project in the final contract amount of \$540,825.00.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the contractor, Allied Painting, Inc., 4 Larwin Road, Cherry Hill, NJ 08034 is now hereby authorized to post a Maintenance Bond in said amount of \$540,825.00 which represents 100% of the total construction costs; said Bond to be in effect for a period of two years from the date of acceptance hereby established as of August 3, 2021.


