

**RESOLUTION #224-2020**

**AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR  
MUNICIPAL BUILDING ROOF MAINTENANCE PROJECT THROUGH  
THE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES COMMISSION OF NEW JERSEY  
COOPERATIVE PRICING AGREEMENT TO  
WEATHERPROOFING TECHNOLOGIES INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey has determined there is a need for a Municipal Building Roof Maintenance Project for the Margate City Municipal Building; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution #135-2019 on June 6, 2019 authorized the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City to become a participating member of the Educational Services Commission Cooperative Pricing System; and

**WHEREAS**, Weatherproofing Technologies Inc. is a participating member of the Educational Services Cooperative Pricing System #65MCESCCPS and has submitted a proposal for Municipal Building Roof Maintenance Project for Margate City Municipal Building in the amount of \$727,825.01; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified to the Commission that there are funds in the amount of \$727,825.01 available for the purpose of a contract in Ord 02-2020 account: C-04-55-985-902;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City is duly authorized to accept the proposal from Weatherproofing Technologies Inc. for the Municipal Building Roof Maintenance Project for \$727,825.01.
