

RESOLUTION #235-2020
AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR SALE OF BEACH BADGES
THROUGH ALTERNATIVE METHODS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, in the County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey desire to enable an Electronic Beach Badge System; and

WHEREAS, Andrew Miles, Director of Community Education and Recreation, submitted a letter on November 17, 2020 recommending Vilpy LLC, PO Box 153, Manasquan, NJ 08736 as per their proposal of 2.9% per beach badge fee; and

WHEREAS, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, County of Atlantic, State of New Jersey that it does hereby award a contract to Vilpy LLC, PO Box 153, Manasquan, NJ 08736, as per their proposal for the Electric Beach Badge System in an amount of 2.9% per beach badge cost, to be incurred by the beach badge purchaser and that the award of contract be advertised according to law one time in the Press of Atlantic City newspaper.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the award of contract is conditioned upon the delivery and execution thereof within ten (10) days from the date of the resolution accompanied by such appropriate insurance certificate, affirmative action certificate and performance bond as may be required by the specifications.


