

RESOLUTION #30-2023

**ACCEPTING FY 2022 FEMA BUILDING RESILIENT
INFRASTRUCTURE AND COMMUNITIES GRANT MONEYS
UNDER FLOOD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE NO. DR-4488**

WHEREAS, a grant from The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) under the Flood Mitigation Assistance Program, as part of the FY2022 Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Grant (BRIC), in the amount of one million, seven hundred seventy-eight thousand, nine hundred three dollars and thirty-six cents (\$1,778,903.36) has become available to the City of Margate City; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this grant is to assist the City in achieving flood resiliency such as redeveloping the Adams Avenue Pump Station.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Margate City’s FY 2021 BRIC grant application was denied; and

WHEREAS, City of Margate agrees to pay their required share of the cost of this grant in the amount ninety-seven thousand, nine hundred ninety-two dollars and sixty-four cents \$97,992.64.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the City of Margate City, Atlantic County, New Jersey hereby accept the grant of “FY 2022 FEMA Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Grant Flood Mitigation Assistance Program No. DR-4488” the sum of one million, seven hundred seventy-eight thousand, nine hundred three dollars and thirty-six cents (\$1,778,903.36).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk are reauthorized to execute grant agreements pertaining there to “FY 2022 FEMA Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities Grant Flood Mitigation Assistance Program No. DR-4488”.


